DURING THE AFTERNOON HOURS OF 21 AUGUST, ANALYSIS OF [REDACTED] AIR SURVEILLANCE AND [REDACTED] VOICE COMMUNICATIONS REFLECTED THE REACTION, ENGAGEMENT, AND SHOOTDOWN OF AT LEAST ONE HOSTILE AIRCRAFT BY A CHOCOM FIGHTER NEAR THE DRV/CHINA BORDER. AN UNIDENTIFIED NUMBER OF HOSTILE AIRCRAFT PENETRATED CHICOM AIRSPACE AT 0509 AND ACCORDING TO OPERATIONAL DATA TWO OF THREE U.S. A6A AIRCRAFT REPORTEDLY ACTIVE IN THE AREA AT THIS GENERAL TIME FAILED TO RECOVER ABOARD THE USS CONSTELLATION. [REDACTED] VOICE COMMUNICATIONS REVEAL THAT ONE OF THE HOSTILES WAS SHOT DOWN BY A [REDACTED] FIGHTER. (SEE [REDACTED] SPOT REPORT 21 [REDACTED] VCK/R161-67, 210726Z AUGUST 67, [REDACTED] 210621Z). ALSO DURING THE AFTERNOON OF 21 AUGUST [REDACTED] MIGS WERE REPORTEDLY ACTIVE OVER THE GULF OF TONKIN. THERE ARE NO [REDACTED] AIR SURVEILLANCE OR [REDACTED] VOICE COMMUNICATIONS THAT MIGHT SUBSTANTIATE THE REPORTED ACTIVITY IN THE GULF OF TONKIN (SEE [REDACTED] 210841Z). BETWEEN 0855 AND 0908 ON 21 AUGUST, DRV AIR SURVEILLANCE FACILITIES REFLECTED AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF DRV MIGS IN A PROBABLE FLIGHT TO CHINA. A COMPUTED GROUND SPEED OF 615 KNOTS INDICATES THE AIRCRAFT ARE MIG-21S (SEE USA-32 SPOT REPORT 2/H3/VCK/R101-67, 211325Z).

BETWEEN 0855 AND 0900 ON 21 AUGUST, DRV AIR SURVEILLANCE FACILITIES REFLECTED AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF DRV MIGS IN A PROBABLE FLIGHT TO CHINA. A COMPUTED GROUND SPEED OF 615 KNOTS INDICATES THE AIRCRAFT ARE MIG-21S (SEE USA-32 SPOT REPORT 2/H3/VCK/R101-67, 211325Z).
