ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THIS SUMMARY IS BASED ENTIRELY ON SIGINT EXCEPT WHERE SOURCE IS OTHERWISE IDENTIFIED. PART ONE-RESUME OF SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENTS. ON 23 NOVEMBER AN RF-4C WAS SHOT DOWN APPROXIMATELY FIVE NAUTICAL MILES WEST OF DONG HOI BY NORTH VIETNAMESE AAA FIRE. NORTH VIETNAMESE SAM ASSOCIATED COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES REPORTED THE SHOOT DOWN AND SUBSEQUENT CAPTURE OF AN AIRCREWMAN. COLLATERAL MATERIAL REVEALS THAT AN RF4C WAS DOWNED NEAR 17-28N 106-32E ON 23 NOVEMBER (SEE [REDACTED] FOLLOW UPS TO USA-32 CRITIC 11-68, 231057Z). A CONTINUATION OF NORTH VIETNAMESE TRANSPORT ACTIVITY INVOLVING LIUCHOU, CHINA WHICH BEGAN ON 04 NOVEMBER WAS NOTED ON 24 NOVEMBER WHEN NVAF AN-24/1092 CONDUCTED A ROUND TRIP FLIGHT FROM LIUCHOU TO YUNNANI. THIS TRANSPORT PERFORMED SIMILAR FLIGHTS ON 19, 20 AND 22 NOVEMBER. ON 22 AND 23 NOVEMBER AT LEAST 21 POSSIBLY 24 MIG-15/17 AIRCRAFT, TENTATIVELY IDENTIFIED AS SUBORDINATE TO THE NORTHVIET- NAMESE AIRFORCE FLEW FROM POSSIBLY YUNNANI TO LIUCHOU VIA NANNING WUYU AIRFIELD. THE AIRCRAFT WERE FLOWN BY [REDACTED] PILOTS (SEE 21 [REDACTED] VCA/R159-68, 250726Z). AN ADDITIONAL SUBSCRIBER (MX4372) WAS INITIALLY NOTED ACTIVE IN COMMUNICATIONS CONTROLLED BY THE CONSTRUCTION-RELATED UNIT (MX0057) ON 23 NOVEMBER. THIS RADIO GROUP POSSIBLY SERVES THREE CONSTRUCTION- RELATED UNITS (MX4327, MX4328 AND MX4330) AND AN UNIDENTIFIED UNIT (MX4329). TWO OF THESE CONSTRUCTION-RELATED UNITS (MX4327 AND MX4328) ARE LOCATED IN THE MUONG LA AND PHONG SALLY AREAS OF LAOS, RESPECTIVELY. THE OTHER TWO UNITS (MX4329 AND MX4330) ARE LOCATED IN THE LAO CAI/ CHINA BORDER AREA. A LOCATION FOR THE UNIT (MX4372) HAS YET TO BE DETERMINED (SEE 2103Z [REDACTED] R76-68, 231500Z AND PART TWO THIS REPORT).
