INFILTRATION, REAR SERVICES ACTIVITY ORIGINATING IN LAOS, A VEHICLE MOVEMENT REPORT ON 20 APRIL, WAS THE SUBJECT OF A DISPATCH FROM THE 31ST ENGINEER BATTALION TO PROBABLY BINH TRAM 32. THE BATTALION REPORTED THAT 39 VEHICLES WERE GOING TO NA SAN (UNLOCATED). OF THESE 39 VEHICLES, 18 WERE OF THE 102ND TRANSPORTATION BATTALION. 1111942 REPORTEDLY, 15 VEHICLES WENT DOWN TO KM 119 (LOCATED WITHIN 1000 METERS OF KM 118 ON ROUTE 91 IN THE VICINITY OF XD 209 513, 16-44N 106-07E), 14 OF THE 102ND BATTALION AND ONE FROM THE 90TH BATTALION. TWENTY VEHICLES WERE TO GO DOWN TO KM 72 (LOCATED WITHIN 1000 METERS OF KM 73 ON ROUTE 91 IN THE VICINITY OF WD 985 791, 16-58N 106-55E), FIVE FROM THE 102ND BATTALION AND 15 FROM THE 90TH BATTALION. ADDITIONALLY, THE ORIGINATOR STATED THAT 16 VEHICLES WILL GO OUT TO KMS 72 AND 119 OF WHICH 9 VEHICLES ARE TO BE FROM THE 102ND BATTALION AND SEVEN FROM THE 90TH BATTALION. A 19 APRIL COMMUNIQUE FROM BINH TRAM 32 TO A SUBORDINATE OF BINH TRAM 32 REVEALED THAT THE ENEMY HAS WITHDRAWN AND THAT THE RAINY SEASON WILL AGAIN BECOME KEY FACTOR. THE BINH TRAM DIRECTED THE RECIPIENT TO FIND OUT HOW THE ENEMY DEPLOYED AT THE AIRFIELD AND THE BANKS OF THE STREAM BETWEEN THE AIRFIELD AND NA LAI (AKA BAN NA LAI, XD 10 46, 16-42N 106-02E). THE BINH TRAM ALSO MENTIONED THAT MINES WERE TO BE PLANTED AT THE AIRFIELD AND THAT THE ARTILLERY PLATOONS DO NOT HAVE TO COME DOWN ANYMORE. (2/G11/VCJ/T3476-70) THE ALLEGED SHOOTDOWN OF AN ALLIED AIRCRAFT AND THE SHOOTING INTO FLAMES OF SEVERAL AIRCRAFT WAS DISCLOSED IN A 19 APRIL MESSAGE FROM THE COMMAND POST OF THE 559TH TRANSPORTATION GROUP TO BINH TRAM 34. ACCORDING TO THE REPORT, THE 337TH ENGINEER BATTALION OF BINH TRAM 9 WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR SHOOTING DOWN AN RF-40 ON THE SPOT. GROUP DISCLOSED THAT THE FOLLOWING UNITS SHOT AIRCRAFT INTO FLAMES, 14TH AAA BATTALION OF BINH TRAM 31 28TH AAA BATTALION OF BINH TRAM 44 22ND AAA BATTALION OF BINH TRAM 32 36TH AAA BATTALION OF BINH TRAM 42 AND THE 32ND BATTALION OF BINH TRAM 36. THE ORIGINATOR STATED THAT THREE F-4'S, ONE F-105, AND ONE A-4 WERE THE FIVE AIRCRAFT THAT WERE SHOT INTO FLAMES, HOWEVER, THE MESSAGE DID NOT MENTION WHICH UNIT SHOT WHICH AIRCRAFT. TRANSPORTATION OF RICE WAS REVEALED IN A 19 APRIL COMMUNIQUE FROM PROBABLY K-191 (WAREHOUSE/TRANSHIPMENT POINT, LOCATED AT BEN THUY, WF 74 61, 18-38N 105-40E) TO THE ORDNANCE SECTION OF K-218 (UNLOCATED). REPORTEDLY, THE AMOUNT OF RICE AT THE CHO SI (LOCATED AT WG 60 41, 19-00N 105-35E) RAILROAD STATION DESTINED FOR AN UNSPECIFIED PLACE ALONG ROUTE 7, WHICH IS TO BE SENT OUT FROM 11 APRIL TO 18 APRIL IS AS FOLLOWS, RECEIVED, 183 TONS, 750 KG SENT OUT, 292 TONS REMAINING, 667 TONS, 410 KG. (2/G11/VCJ/T3468-70) VI. NORTH VIETNAM, DIRECTIVES TO STRAIN ALL THE COMRADES AND REPORT THE ENEMY SITUATION EVERY

ADDITIONAL HIGHLY CORRUPT TEXT MENTIONED THAT GENERAL STAFF IN SOCI- ATION WITH AN UNSPECIFIED MISSION. (2/G11/VCM/T1735-78 AND CHANGE ONE) CHANGE TO 2/G11/VCJ/R123-78, IN SECTION I, SUBSECTION C, CANCEL THE 2ND AND 3RD SENTENCES IN PARAGRAPH 6, WHICH READ AS FOLLOWS, QUOTE FIGURES WERE PASSED ON 18 APRIL FROM THE 3RD BATTALION OF THE REGIMENT TO THE REGIMENTAL HEADQUARTERS THAT 116 TROOPS ATTACKED AT 544. THE MESSAGE FURTHER REPORTED THAT COMPANY 3 WAS UNABLE TO CARRY OUT THE AMBUSH BECAUSE THE ENEMY HAD MOVED. UNQUOTE XXHH 888 NNNN
