1 Jul 21  1	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant G. I. Naughton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny of military property, dereliction of duty, obstructing justice, and wrongfully disposing of military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 16 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
7 Jul 21  2	I MIG, I MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal J. K. Climaco, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, 60 days of restriction, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for one month, and reduction to E-1.
8 Jul 21  3	II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. D. Arthur, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months of confinement and reduction to E-1.
8 Jul 21  4	MCES, TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class C. E. Rhoads, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order, failure to obey an other lawful order, assault consummated by battery, unlawful entry, and drunkenness. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 Jul 21  5	MarForCom	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private First Class T. N. Martin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of aggravated assault, assault consummated by battery, assault upon a law enforcement officer, communicating a threat, willfully damaging military property, resisting apprehension, and drunk and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 15 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

14 Jul 21 6	7thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Corporal A. B. Franco, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 140 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
14 Jul 21 7	VMFA-121, MAG-12, 1stMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. C. Ensminger, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
15 Jul 21 8	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal T. J. Leger of sexual assault. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 18 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
15 Jul 21 9	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal J. L. MartinezAguilar, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 20 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
15 Jul 21 10	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. J. Craig, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, providing false and misleading information to civilian law enforcement, and willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
16 Jul 21 11	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. R. Jarrett, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 16 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
17 Jul 21 12	MCI-W	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Gunnery Sergeant S. J. Ramirez of making false official statements and assault consummated by battery. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-6, 60 days restriction with hard labor, and a reprimand.

19 Jul 21 13	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal I. S. Jones, pursuant to the accused's plea, of viewing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
19 Jul 21 14	MACG-18, 1stMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Corporal J. S. Rosales, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny of military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 181 days of confinement and a reduction to E-1.
19 Jul 21 15	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant C. D. Padua, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted sexual assault of a child and attempted sexual abuse of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 13 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
21 Jul 21 16	NMRTC, Twenty-nine Palms	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Hospital Corpsman 1st Class R. E. Dini, U.S. Navy, of dereliction of duty. The military judge sentenced the accused to 100 days of confinement and reduction to E-5.
22 Jul 21 17	CLB-2, CLR-2, 2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant M. B. McGlone, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted possession of a controlled substance, violating a lawful general order, and wrongful possession and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 32 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
22 Jul 21 18	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal C. Marin of attempted sexual assault. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 18 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

23 Jul 21 19	1stMardiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal G. Huerta Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny of non-military property, conspiracy to commit larceny, knowingly using a credit card without authorization to obtain property, escaping from custody, unauthorized absence, and attempted fraudulent use of a debit card and a credit card. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 18 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
28 Jul 21 20	Hq&HqRon, MCAS Miramar	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Logistics Specialist 3rd Class S. T. Adams, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's plea, of indecent recording. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to no punishment.
28 Jul 21 21	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal Z. R. Hunt, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 35 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
28 Jul 21 22	1stBn, 6thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. P. Roche, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 5 months, and reduction to E-1.
29 Jul 21 23	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal P. Z. Hejna, in a case with mixed pleas and no plea agreement, of larceny of military property, obstructing justice, and making a false official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
29 Jul 21 24	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal S. M. Swisher of sexual assault, attempted sexual assault, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. The accused elected sentencing by the military judge; the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 54 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
