REVENUE MARINE.

TREASURY DEPARTMENT,

NOVEMBER 1st, 1845.

From and after the receipt of this order, no Paints, other than Black and White, with their admixture (Lead Color) will be allowed to the Revenue Vessels, or permitted to be used on board. ~~except~~ *Red Lead for Iron work.*
The use of Gold Leaf, except upon the head and stern carving, is likewise prohibited.

With a view to economy, and the establishment of uniformity, a strict compliance with this order is required.
