4 Jan 21 1	2dBn, 7thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. P. Kitka, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and conspiracy. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 15 days of confinement and reduction to E-2.
6 Jan 21 2	MAG-11, 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Corporal D. Clifton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery and drunk and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 13 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$300 pay per month for 1 month, and reduction to E-3.
6 Jan 21 3	6thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. T. Floyd, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance and violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 55 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
7 Jan 21 4	1stMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. J. Drake of failure to obey a lawful order and assault consummated by battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months of confinement and reduction to E-2.
7 Jan 21 5	1stCEB, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. W. Cooper, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny and fraudulent use of a credit card. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
7 Jan 21 6	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
8 Jan 21 7	I MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. H. Graham III, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$500 pay per month for 6 months, reduction to E-1, 60 days of restriction, and 90 days of hard labor.

11 Jan 21 8	HqHqSqdrn, MCAS Miramar	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Private First Class C. M. Kornacki, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and possession of controlled substances, failure to obey a lawful order, and breaching restriction. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
11 Jan 21 9	1st MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class T. R. Buenerkemper, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and wrongful use and distribution of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 15 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
14 Jan 21 10	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. R. Helean, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use, possession, and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 13 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
14 Jan 21 11	3dBn, 3dMarReg, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. R. Cameron, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, communicating a threat, stalking, obstructing justice, and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
14 Jan 21 12	3dBn, 3dMarReg, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Private First Class T. M. Hile, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 35 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
14 Jan 21 13	4thMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. Vasquez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child and attempted production of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 20 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

14 Jan 21 14	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. P. Bowin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child not involving sexual contact. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 8 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
15 Jan 21 15	4thRTR, MCRD Parris Island	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
19 Jan 21 16	2dRTR, MCRD Parris Island	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
20 Jan 21 17	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted First Lieutenant S. S. Piele, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abusive sexual contact and assault consummated by battery upon a commissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal, 90 days of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a reprimand.
21 Jan 21 18	I MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted First Lieutenant E. C. Bell, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, communicating a threat, and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal and 36 months of confinement.
27 Jan 21 19	II MIG, II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant C. E. Barron, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1.
28 Jan 21 20	4thMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Sergeant R. W. Thistle, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 40 days of confinement.
29 Jan 21 21	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
29 Jan 21 22	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. P. Rivero, pursuant to the accused's plea, of sexual assault of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 12 years of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
