3 Dec 20	MCSF Bn, MCSF Reg, MARFORCOM	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Master at Arms Second Class B. H. Slater, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement and reduction to E-3.
4 Dec 20	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. A. Cabrera, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order, making a false official statement, assault consummated by battery, and aggravated assault. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, five months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
5 Dec 20	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members convicted Sergeant M. A. Champion-Flores of failure to obey an other lawful order, sexual assault, and extramarital sexual conduct. The accused elected sentencing by the military judge; the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 32 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
8 Dec 20	VMFAT-501, MAG-31, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Corporal A. D. Brown, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession, introduction, distribution, and use of controlled substances and failure to obey an other lawful order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,155 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
9 Dec 20	MWSS-371, 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, a military judge convicted Corporal A. A. Rodriguez Jr., pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 60 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 Dec 20	1stMaintBn, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal C. D. Williams, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of simple assault, assault consummated by battery, and drunk and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 58 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$800 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.

9 Dec 20	CLR-3, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Private First Class E. G. Saeteroslema, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
10 Dec 20	MCB Quantico	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. J. Delafuente of sexual assault. The military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 48 months of confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
10 Dec 20	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members convicted Private First Class T. D. Williams of sexual assault, abusive sexual contact, assault consummated by battery, and simple assault. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 11 years of confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
11 Dec 20	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal D. L. Hare, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 18 months of confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
11 Dec 20	Trng Cmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. E. Miller, pursuant to the accused's plea, of larceny of non-military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 3 months of confinement.
11 Dec 20	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
14 Dec 20	VMFAT-501, MAG-31, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Corporal A. M. Ragsdale, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession, introduction, distribution, and use of controlled substances and obstruction of justice. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 11 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,155.00 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.

15 Dec 20	MACS-2, MACG-28, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted First Lieutenant L. C. Gonzalez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order, extramarital sexual conduct, and fraternization. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a reprimand.
16 Dec 20	CNATT, MCAS Cherry Point	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. R. Tribble, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement, aggravated assault, and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 6 months of confinement.
17 Dec 20	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal D. G. Lyle of possession and distribution of child pornography. The accused elected sentencing by the military judge; the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 8 years of confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
17 Dec 20	H&S Bn, Camp Lejeune	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
18 Dec 20	MRSNG, MARFORSOC	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal A. J. Lobik, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, aggravated assault, and willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 244 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
18 Dec 20	Trng Cmd	At a general court-martial at the Washington Navy Yard, a military judge convicted Private D. L. McCormick, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 6 months of confinement.
21 Dec 20	2dMaintBn, 2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant G. W. Rardin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order, assault consummated by battery, and indecent language. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 119 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,155 pay per month for 3 months, reduction to E-1, and 60 days of restriction.

22 Dec 20	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lieutenant Commander M. E. Haller, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willful dereliction of duty, possession of a controlled substance, and conduct unbecoming. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal and a reprimand.
29 Dec 20	4th MCD	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Sergeant K. J. Taylor, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, violating lawful general orders, and willful dereliction of duty. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,155 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
