

USS PUEBLO RELEASE SUMMARY #3

This is the third in a series of NSA transparency releases of previously classified archival documents pertaining to the North Korean seizure of the U.S.S. Pueblo in international waters in January 1968. The 50 documents in this release comprise 105 pages of material, including maps, NSA memoranda, briefings, chronologies, and other miscellaneous documents. The subjects covered include: The mission of the Pueblo; the patrol and capture; U.S. and North Korean reactions; perceived relevant questions and answers regarding the Pueblo, its mission, and NSA policy which were prepared by NSA staff members for use in responding to Congress and U.S. government officials; and information gathered for damage assessments. The documents in this release provide additional information on the Pueblo Incident and should prove valuable to researchers and other interested parties.
