SUBJECT: Draft Reply to Questions Asked by Senator Fullbright Relating to USS PUEBLO - File Town St. Co.

- 1. This responds to your memorandum of 23 February 1968.
- 2. The re-draft of the responses to Senator Fullbright's questions is satisfactory to NSA, subject to the following:
- a. In the last sentence, answer to Question 7, The positions of the Pueblo as indicated in her reporting between the time she broke radio silence at 230150 Z to her capture shortly after 230430 Z are as follows: request that the phrase "shortly after 230430 Z be deleted inasmuch as our information indicates that the actual capture may not have occurred until some time after 230532 Z.
- b. On the page following the one where the above sentence occurs, under the date 23 January 0150%, the next sentence begins, "Pueblo broke radio silence, transmitted the following information:", request that the phrase broke radio silence" be deleted inasmuch as the PUEBLO had previously broken radio silence at 220820%.
- 3. In the compilation of transmissions sent and received by USS PUEBLO, the sheets drafted to be used in place of pages II and 22 are satisfactory to NSA.
