CRITIC from COMNAVFORJAPAN received. The SNOO notified B group operations center who, in turn, began notifying key personnel from Bl. At 230005 Gen. Carter, Gen. Morrison, Adm. Schulz, [redacted] (ADNSG), [redacted] and other P2 personnel were notified. At 230020 Gen. Morrison reported in followed very shortly by [redacted], [redacted] Mr. Leonard Bienvenu, Mr. Dick Harvey, K, Mr. Zaslow, [redacted] and Mr. Apollony of B, and the undersigned. At this time the duty officer at NSS advised that he had notified [redacted]

Gen. Morrison notified Dr. Tordella. [redacted] (S Duty Officer) called in.

Gen. Carter called the Command Center and advised Gen. Morrison that he had just received a call from Mr. Walter Rostow regarding the PUEBLO. Gen. Carter informed Gen. Morrison that Mr. Rostow wished to know what procedures were applicable in such instances. Gen. Carter told Mr. Rostow that there was a clear division of responsibility between NSA and the JCS in connection with such reconnaissance patrols. NSA provides technical guidance and support for the SIGINT collection mission; however, JCS retains full responsibility for deployment of ships to include evaluation of physical risk factors. Therefore, it appeared that any action regarding the PUEBLO at this point was a matter of JCS cognizance (per Gen. Morrison).

In response to an earlier request from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] JRC, (230300) Gen. Morrison advised the Captain that, according to information available to NSA the PUEBLO departed YOKOSUKA for SASEBO on 4 Jan and subsequently departed SASEBO on 10 Jan for her patrol area. According to the "Sail orders" the PUEBLO was to sail under EMCON throughout her patrol until and if she encountered Soviet Naval Units in the Tsushima Straits area. Therefore, until the incident we had received no messages from the ship.
