ADDITIONAL INFORMATION NOTED IN COMINT AT 0710Z ON 24 JANUARY INDI-

CATES THAT THE NEW TYPES OF EQUIPMENT ABOARD THE PUEBLO WERE DESTROY-

ED. IT WAS MENTIONED THAT THE WONSAN BASE COMMANDER WOULD IDEN-

TIFY THE REMAINING EQUIPMENT AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE TIME. AND

THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT AND THE CHIEF OF FIRE

POWER DIVISION WERE CONDUCTING A SEARCH OF THE SHIP SINCE YESTER-
