- Comments: [1] MARCH: Possibly Simon Davidovich KREMER, whose efficial post was Secretary to the Soviet Military Attaché in LOMDON. He was appointed in 1937 and is thought to have left sometime in 1946. The covername MARCH cocurs as a LOMDON addressee and signatory between 3rd March 1940 and 9th October 1940, after which it is supermeded by the covername RRION.
  - [11] LOUISA: Almost certainly an error by MOSCOW for MUSE
    [MUZA]. In No. 949 of 27th August 1940 LONDON asked for
    MUSE's radio schedule for several months and for cipher
    instructions; this message is on an appropriate date to be
    MOSCOW's reply. Furthermore, paragraph 3 of LONDON's No.
    987 of 6th September 1940 (the day after the present message was repeated) schmowledges receipt by MUSE "yesterday"
    of a 30-group message: the present message is 30 clipher
    groups long. The error can be explained by the similarity
    between MUZA and LUISA in Cyrillic longhand.
