4 Jun 21 1	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. E. Bailey, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
4 Jun 21 2	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members convicted Sergeant R. F. Graziano of violating a lawful general order. The members sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$1,186 pay per month for 2 months, reduction to E-3, and 60 days of restriction.
8 Jun 21 3	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal L. A. Ingram, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing and distributing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 42 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
9 Jun 21 4	1stTSB, CLR-1, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. Sanchez, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 75 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
11 Jun 21 5	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
14 Jun 21 6	1stTSB, CLR-1, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal J. J. Villalba, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance, making a false official statement, and obstructing justice. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 120 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
15 Jun 21 7	CLR-27, 2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. M. Rojas, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and introduction of a controlled substance and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 100 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,100 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.

15 Jun 21 8	WRR	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, a military judge convicted Corporal C. N. Smith, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing child pornography and obstructing justice. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 36 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
16 Jun 21 9	1stTSB, CLR-1, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. G. Salcido, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement and reduction to E-2.
16 Jun 21 10	2dCEB, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. A. Rescavage, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 90 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
17 Jun 21 11	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a panel of members convicted Hospital Corpsman Third Class M. W. Williams, U.S. Navy, of negligent dereliction of duty. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1.
17 Jun 21 12	7thESB, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. A. Serrano, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful possession of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
18 Jun 21 13	4thMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal S. B. London of involuntary manslaughter. The accused elected sentencing by the military judge. The military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 65 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
22 Jun 21 14	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. D. Torres, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating lawful general orders and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 134 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

24 Jun 21 15	MARFOREUR/AF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
24 Jun 21 16	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
25 Jun 21 17	MCAS-NR	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. A. Bullard, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of failure to go to an appointed place of duty, resisting apprehension, willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, wrongful use of a controlled substance, communicating threats, assault upon a law enforcement officer, and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 13 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
28 Jun 21 18	CNATT, MCAS-NR	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal C. J. Wheelus, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of aggravated assault, resisting apprehension, disrespect toward a superior commissioned officer, violating lawful general orders, communicating threats, and assault upon a law enforcement officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 136 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
28 Jun 21 19	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Private C. H. Sanchez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing and distributing child pornography and making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 14 months of confinement.
29 Jun 21 20	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal V. J. Rapacciuolo, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography and abusive sexual contact. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 400 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
30 Jun 21 21	MCI-E	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal J. D. C. Ducut, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 22 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
