Notes: [a] It is not clear whether KURBO and FERRUCHE are the subject or not of this sentence.

[b] Referred to in STOCKHOLM's No. 519 of 18th March 1942 (not yet published).

Comments: [1] AKASTO : Col. N. I. NIKITUSHEV, Soviet Military Attaché in STOCKHOLM.

[11] KURBO : Unidentified. Possibly a transcription of a French name such as Courbaud, Courbot. See also MOSCOW's No. 221 24th March 1942 (3/NBP/T1588) and STOCKHOLM's No. 713 16th April 1942 (3/NBP/T1589). There are other unpublished occurrences in March 1942.

[111] FERRUCHE : Unidentified. Presumably the French surname. Also occurs in MOSCOW's No. 221 of 24th March 1942 (3/NBP/T

[1v] NORTHERN : MOSCOW signatory and addressee, so far only occurring messages sent in the Scandinavian lanes. Probably Northern Department.
