- Comments: [i] AKASTO: ✓ Col. M.I. NIMTUSHOV, Soviet Military Attache in STOCKHOLM.
- [ii] TALMUD: ✓ Coverword for cipher or cipher system.
- [iii] ANDERSON: X Norwegian RIS courier between SWEDEN and NORWAY. He arrived in the U.K. on 26th October 1942. <sup>Handwritten note:</sup> He had been in contact with T1687 for some time. He had been in contact with T1687 for some time. He had been in contact with T1687 for some time.
- [iv] SVANTE: X RIS agent a Norwegian
- [v] FRED: X a Norwegian RIS agent
- [vi] ✓ LEVANGER: X Unidentified. This could be a Norwegian surname or covername. Also occurs in STOCKHOLM's No. 6 of 7th January 1942 (3/NBP/T1890), No. 1534 of 21st July 1942 (3/NBP/T1675) and No. 3135 of 25th November 1943 (3/NBP/T1579).
- [vii] MARYM: X Unidentified covername. Also occurs in MOSCO's No. 118 of 18th February 1942 (3/NBP/T1741) and No. 209 of 19th March 1942 (3/NBP/T1717). MARYM is a place name. These are often used as covernames in this traffic.
- [viii] IV/NOV: X Unidentified. First occurrence.
- [ix] NORTHERN: X MOSCO; addressee and signatory. Probably Northern Department.
- [x] LAMOV: X Col. BALTENKO, cipher officer in MOSCO..
