The captains and service commanders [VOENNYJ KOMENDANT] of merchant vessels in their reports give absolutely no account of military/political and other matters arising during passage and stay in foreign ports. For the purpose of standardising the reports and obtaining information of interest to us please [1 group unrecovered]

Send ANDREEV<sup>[1]</sup> the instructions given to the captains and service commanders of our vessels and the lay-out of the reports which are sent out to me through [B% TAYLOR's [TAYLOR]]<sup>[11]</sup> people [8 groups unrecoverable] 100 copies of handbooks of the U.S. Navy and instructions for identifying merchant vessels for captains and commanders.
