TELEPHONE MESSAGE TO 'ERIC' ABOUT A GERMAN
AIR ATTACK ON MAGNITOGORSK.

To: MOSCOW

11 June 1943

To the Chief Director[1].

On [C: 10th] June at 10 o'clock in the morning the METRO[11] was telephoned by an unknown person who only had time to say to ERIC [ERIK][111] "[1: group unrecovered] the Germans are preparing to make an attack on MAGNITOGORSK with 2,000 aircraft." At that moment the telephone was cut off by the exchange. Whether [C: this] was provocation or fact it is hard to judge, but I think it must be reported.
