Legation [MISSIYA] Attaché MOROZOV, Georgij Mikhajlovich (henceforth "~~ROLAND~~" [ ]) is being recalled home. In April [B<sup>o</sup> 1944] [i] you reported that he showed himself to be self-centred, a man of stone [KAMENNYM CHELOVEKOM], reserved in his manner, friendly only with ALEKSANDR [ii] and VLASOV, [and when] [a] associating with foreigners disclosed many things to them. In his private capacity "~~ROLAND~~" had made friends with a local journalist, ALEXANDER [ALEKSANDER], often visiting him [,] and you supposed that [B<sup>o</sup> ALEXANDER] was skilfully making use of him. From that time no information has been received from you about "~~ROLAND~~".

Taking the maximum care and observing secrecy [KONSPIRATSIYA], arrange for secret surveillance of him
