MCSOW. Advise whether you know about his arrival in [M STOCKHOIM] from
official sources. If BROWNER applies to our Legation for any technical
assistance, everything possible should be done, as is usually done for
[M private] citizens travelling to the USSR on personal business. Telegration
(M information] about the date of B.'s departure for MCSOW. Appropriate
(M instructions) have been given to the envoy through Ministry of Foreign
Affairs [MID][a] chammels.
