[ii] ATHLETD: X Probably a coverword for a type of agent.

[iii] BYVShLJ: X i.e. "FORMER" or "CI-DEVANT"; unidentified covername. Also occurs in MOSCOW's Nos. 434 of 10th Hovember 1945 (3/NBF/T132, Item 1) and 213 of 4th Hay 1946 (3/NBF/T1895) and CANEIRRA's Nos. 259 of 14th November 1945 (3/NBF/T132, Item 2) and 155 of 13th July 1947 (3/NBF/T773).

[iv] KUZNETSOVA:

Probably Raissa SZAJEWSKI née HIRSCH a ballet teacher known professionally as Madame KOUSNETZCVA; asseciate; with the pro-Soviet Russian Social Club in SYDNEY.

[v] REPINA: /

Almost certainly a member of the family of Ivan Dimitri REPIN, prominent member of the pro-Soviet section of the Russian community in SYDNEY: either Alexandra REPINA (his wife), Ethel Alice REPINA (his sister-in-law) or Dr Stella REPINA HOTIMSKY (his daughter).

[vi] SMIRNOVA:

Probably Elsie LFAHY, formerly (1941 to at least 1947) SMIRNOFF/SMIRNOVA, formerly SURREST; nee POCLICCHI; associated with the pro-Soviet Russian Social Club in SYDNEY.
