1 Apr 21 1	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
2 Apr 21 2	II MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
5 Apr 21 3	3dBn, 3dMarReg, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. C. McIntyre, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 136 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
7 Apr 21 4	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lieutenant W. N. Nickel II, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willful dereliction of duty, wrongful possession and use of controlled substances, drunk driving, conduct unbecoming, and unauthorized absence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal, 7 months of confinement, 60 days of restriction, and a reprimand.
8 Apr 21 5	1stBn, 1stMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. Spatz of assault consummated by battery and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 70 days of confinement and reduction to E-3.
9 Apr 21 6	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, a military judge convicted Corporal A. J. Taveira, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use, possession, and distribution of controlled substances and willful dereliction of duty. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 11 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 Apr 21 7	5thBn, 11thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. A. Sanchez Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

12 Apr 21 8	3dMarReg, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Corporal I. S. Prioleau, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abusive sexual contact, battery, and burglary. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,100 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
12 Apr 21 9	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. N. Butler Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 30 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
15 Apr 21 10	3dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members convicted Private B. L. Grubb of sexual assault of a child. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 4 years of confinement, and total forfeiture of all pay and allowances.
16 Apr 21 11	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted First Lieutenant D. A. Lewis, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conduct unbecoming and fraternization. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal, 4 days of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a reprimand.
19 Apr 21 12	MCI-W	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. Franco Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of damaging non-military property, communicating threats, simple assault upon an intimate partner, and aggravated assault with a dangerous weapon upon an intimate partner. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
20 Apr 21 13	FAST, MCSFR	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private A. J. Gonzalezbravo, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and simple assault. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement and forfeiture of \$500 pay per month for 2 months.

21 Apr 21 14	3dBn, 3dMarReg, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Corporal K. L. Hunter Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny and accessing a government computer to obtain protected information for an unauthorized purpose. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
21 Apr 21 15	MCAS, MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant R. A. Tarter, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of soliciting the commission of an offense and possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 6 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
21 Apr 21 16	2dTSB, CLR-2, 2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. N. McKenzie, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny of non-military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 112 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
21 Apr 21 17	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. R. Midkiff, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
23 Apr 21 18	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
23 Apr 21 19	SESBn, MCB Camp Pendleton	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal A. P. Herney, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongfully using a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 15 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
26 Apr 21 20	HqSptBn, SOI-W, TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. A. Martin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy, knowingly using a stolen credit card, failure to obey a lawful order, and making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, a \$750 fine, and reduction to E-1.

28 Apr 21 21	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class R. Batista, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use, possession, and introduction of a controlled substance, violation of a lawful general order, possession of child pornography, and, attempted wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 50 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
28 Apr 21 22	MCI-East	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal J. L. Dutcher, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and wrongful introduction of a controlled substance with the intent to distribute. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 15 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
28 Apr 21 23	SESBN, MCB Camp Pendleton	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. A. Kimble, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and possession of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 2 months, and reduction to E-1.
29 Apr 21 24	LOGCOM	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Corporal K. B. Westover, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 16 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
29 Apr 21 25	ACTS, TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Private First Class K. Rodriguezmenses, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful distribution of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,190 pay per month for 11 months, and reduction to E-1.
30 Apr 21 26	1stBn, 10thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal B. T. Lang, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of use of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$250 pay per month for 2 months, reduction to E-1, and 60 days of restriction.
