3 Sep 21 1	CLR-17, 2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. E. Merritt, pursuant to the accused's plea, of violating a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 50 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
8 Sep 21 2	III MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. R. Romanillacres, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of damaging non-military property, assault consummated by battery, and assault consummated by battery on a spouse or intimate partner. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 26 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
14 Sep 21 3	WRR	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant D. A. Wilson, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, aggravated assault by strangulation upon an intimate partner, and assault consummated by battery upon an intimate partner. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 23 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
14 Sep 21 4	3dMLG	At a special court martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Private C. B. Massey, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery on a child under the age of 16 or spouse or intimate partner or immediate family member. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 270 days of confinement, and forfeiture of \$1,190 pay per month for six months.
16 Sep 21 5	3dMLG	At a general court martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant R. P. Sanchez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement, sexual abuse of a child involving sexual contact, and assault consummated by battery on a child under the age of 16 or spouse or intimate partner or immediate family member. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentence the accused to a dishonorable discharge and 24 months of confinement.
17 Sep 21 6	CLR-27, 2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.

17 Sep 21 7	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
17 Sep 21 8	1stMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal I. A. Hernandezflores of assault consummated by battery. The members sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 12 months, reduction to E-1, and 60 days of restriction.
20 Sep 21 9	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. F. Lease, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 114 days of confinement.
20 Sep 21 10	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. R. Medlin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 2 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
21 Sep 21 11	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant C. W. Jones, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and carrying a concealed weapon. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1000 pay per month for one month, and reduction to E-1.
21 Sep 21 12	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. R. Macias, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, violating a lawful general order, and conspiracy to violate a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 150 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
22 Sep 21 13	CLR-27, 2d MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant L. S. Severini, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making false official statements and larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 8 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$2,270 pay per month for 8 months, and reduction to E-1.

23 Sep 21 14	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. P. Mathis, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 13 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
25 Sep 21 15	III MEF	At a general court martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
28 Sep 21 16	3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. O. Riveracrespo, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery on a spouse and communicating a threat. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,190 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
30 Sep 21 17	4thMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. W. Hurd, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 9 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
30 Sep 21 18	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. L. Williams, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery, communicating a threat, extramarital sexual conduct, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 180 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
30 Sep 21 19	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal U. O. Aracena, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography and making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 30 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
