3 Aug 21  1	1stBn, 10thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal D. A. Holder, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
5 Aug 21  2	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Paris Island, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant R. M. Nelson, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and adultery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 9 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 Aug 21  3	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal T. J. Fliehman Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 14 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
9 Aug 21  4	2dBn, 4thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. M. Hernandez, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$500 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.
10 Aug 21  5	Ft. Lee MarDet, TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. P. Harvey, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 91 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
11 Aug 21  6	MWSS-272, MAG-26, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal G. M. Cunningham, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance and drunk and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1 and 60 days of restriction.

12 Aug 21 7	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. A. Valdehueza, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child and desertion. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 11 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
12 Aug 21 8	1stBn, 6thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. J. McTiernan, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and wrongful distribution, use, and possession of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 9 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 10 months, and reduction to E-1.
16 Aug 21 9	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. J. Bertadillo, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of failing to go to an appointed place of duty, making a false official statement, damaging non-military property, arson, wrongful possession of controlled substances, unlawful entry, attempt to break restriction, and failure to obey an other lawful order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 32 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
17 Aug 21 10	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted First Lieutenant K. A. Kostrzewski, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful possession of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal, 9 months of confinement, and total forfeiture of all pay and allowances.
17 Aug 21 11	Ft. Leonard Wood MarDet, TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
19 Aug 21 12	2dCEB, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. C. Boyd, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of failing to obey an other lawful order, communicating a threat, and domestic violence against property with intent to intimidate. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 107 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

19 Aug 21 13	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal E. M. Griffith, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual assault of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 195 days of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
19 Aug 21 14	2dRadBn, II MIG, II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. S. Wiles, pursuant to the accused's plea, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 94 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
20 Aug 21 15	1stMarRdrSptBn, MARFORSOC	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal T. E. Elmore, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of damaging non-government property, misappropriation, and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,150 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
23 Aug 21 16	2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Corporal B. Mendez Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement and wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
26 Aug 21 17	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant K. S. Millican, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of aggravated assault, domestic violence, and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
26 Aug 21 18	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
31 Aug 21 19	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. M. Quinn, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 20 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
