Field Support Activities Solid Waste Disposal Area Westside Installation Restoration Site 12, Housing Area Former Naval Station Treasure Island

Work Will Be Performed Between

Monday, March 8, 2021 – Friday, July 30, 2021 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM,

Monday - Friday, excluding holidays

The Navy's contractor, Gilbane, will be working at Former Naval Station Treasure Island within the Solid Waste Disposal Area (SWDA) between Gateview Avenue and Perimeter Road.

WHY IS WORK BEING DONE?	The Navy is preparing to dispose of existing potentially contaminated soil stockpiles and return the SWDA to pre-existing grades
WHAT WILL BE DONE?	 Soil stockpiles will be radiologically surveyed and screened for material potentially presenting an explosive hazard (MPPEH). Stacked shipping containers will surround select stockpiles to protect against potential safety hazards due to MPPEH. Screened stockpiles will be sampled and transported to an offsite landfill. Following stockpile removals, SWDA will be graded with approximately 22,000 cubic yards of imported soil to pre-existing grade. Dust control and air monitoring will be implemented to prevent airborne particulates.
WHERE WILL IT BE DONE?	All work will be performed within the fenced-in SWDA boundary. See attached figures for the work area, the controlled construction zone, and temporary road closures.
HOW WILL IT IMPACT RESIDENTS?	Heavy equipment, large trucks, and field vehicles will be travelling to and from the site on nearby roads. Noise associated with heavy equipment backup alarms is anticipated. During MPPEH screening Perimeter Road will be closed from 8 AM to 5 PM, March 8 through April 30, 2021 (see Figure 1). A controlled construction zone will be setup at the intersection of Gateview Ave. and Avenue B and will be limited to vehicular traffic only (see Figure 2). Trucks transporting waste will abide by US Department of Transportation Safety Compliance measures and will be covered at all times.
