

## **HUNTERS POINT RADIOLOGICAL REEVALUATION**

## **History**

- Evolution of issue (Navy found irregular soil data; Tetra Tech reported scanning issues; Navy found additional issues; Former Tetra Tech employee claims)
- In 2016 Navy suspended property transfer and initiated an extensive data analysis
- In Nov 2017 Navy concluded and EPA reinforced that the Tetra Tech data was not reliable for making decisions
- Parcel A was previously delisted and transferred in 2004

## **Plan Forward**

- Support Parcel A evaluation
- Parcel G work plan released for regulatory and public review on June 15<sup>th</sup>, comment period concludes on August 14<sup>th</sup>
- Address comments and issue Draft Final work plan
- Contract actions underway to facilitate implementation, anticipate being in the field before the end of the year
- Navy hired independent 3<sup>rd</sup> party oversight
- Once progress is made on Parcel G, can proceed with other parcels

## **Navy Commitment**

- Nearly \$1B invested in HPNS cleanup program and will continue to dedicate resources until all successfully completed
- Navy pursuing Contractual Actions
- Navy supporting Multiple Legal Actions
- Incredibly complex issue, while time is of the essence, primary focus is ensuring safe clean up and transfer
