Open Recommendations

There were **1,425** open recommendations issued to **47** DoD Components in **298** DoD OIG reports.

1,345

Corrective Actions

DoD management has agreed to take corrective actions on **1,345** of the **1,425** open recommendations.

\$6.1 Billion in Potential Monetary Benefits

If DoD Components implemented all **50** open recommendations with significant monetary benefits, the DoD could potentially save **\$6.1 billion**.
