2 May 22 1	2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. P. Lindberg, pursuant to the accused's plea, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
3 May 22 2	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal A. Sandoval, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and sexual assault. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 3 years of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
4 May 22 3	II MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. R. Mansera, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 20 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
4 May 22 4	HqBn, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private J. C. Blackwell, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of unauthorized absence, breaking restriction, disrespect towards a superior commissioned officer, and willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 102 days of confinement.
5 May 22 5	2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
5 May 22 6	SESBn, MCB Camp Pendleton	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. D. Lawrence, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and indecent recordings. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 60 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
6 May 22 7	2dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal A. M. Rodriguez, pursuant to the accused's plea, of abusive sexual contact. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 7 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

6 May 22 8	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. J. Tillman, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 5 years of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 May 22 9	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. C. Helton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of unlawful entry and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
10 May 22 10	2dBn, 11thMarReg	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. Bautista, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 5 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
11 May 22 11	MCI-NCR	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. T. Weil, pursuant to the accused's plea, of negligent homicide. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 30 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
12 May 22 12	1stBn, 4thMarReg	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. ResendizCruz, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongfully distributing a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 140 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,200 pay per month for 8 months, and reduction to E-1.
12 May 22 13	HqSvcBn, MARFORPAC	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. Z. Miars, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession and distribution of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 40 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

16 May 22 14	3dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Foster, a military judge convicted Sergeant B. M. Langton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 15 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 May 22 15	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. D. Truss, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual assault, abusive sexual contact, attempted fraternization, solicitation for prostitution, fraternization, sexual harassment, making a false official statement, communicating a threat, and extortion. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 10 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
17 May 22 16	3dBn, 11thMarReg	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal O. ReyesReyes, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,210 pay per month for 90 days, and reduction to E-1.
18 May 22 17	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant D. B. Mosley, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of distribution and possession of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 30 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a reduction to E-1.
20 May 22 18	MARSOC	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. Ramirez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
26 May 22 19	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
