1 Jun 22  1	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private C. A. Aaron, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of unlawful entry, assault consummated by battery, obstructing justice, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 5 months of confinement, and forfeiture of \$500 pay per month for 5 months.
1 Jun 22  2	3dBn, 11thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal P. Zitron, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance and making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 100 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
1 Jun 22  3	MAG-16, 3dMAW	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. J. Rodriguez of violating a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,500 pay for one month, and reduction to E-3.
2 Jun 22  4	1stSupBn, 1stMLG	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. S. Lupo, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance and breaking restriction. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 58 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
3 Jun 22  5	MCB Quantico	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
6 Jun 22  6	HqSptBn, MCB Camp Lejeune, MCI-E	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
9 Jun 22  7	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
9 Jun 22  8	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.

9 Jun 22 9	TrngCmd	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Sailor of all charges and specifications.
10 Jun 22 10	CLR-17, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal C. H. Miller Jr., pursuant to the accused's plea, of violating a lawful regulation. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Jun 22 11	3dBn, 6thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
16 Jun 22 12	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Hospital Corpsman Second Class E. A. Maebane of involuntary manslaughter and reckless endangerment. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 6 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
16 Jun 22 13	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
17 Jun 22 14	2dBn, 4thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class E. I. Stowers, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
21 Jun 22 15	2dBn, 4thMar, 1stMarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class A. D. Kurkcu, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.
22 Jun 22 16	II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
23 Jun 22 17	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private First Class T. A. Booker, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of simple assault and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 104 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

24 Jun 22 18	2dBn, 4thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private Z. J. Long, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement.
28 Jun 22 19	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. C. Johnson, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful possession and distribution of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 135 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
28 Jun 22 20	MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Private C. H. Jones, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and wrongful use and distribution of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 1 year of confinement.
29 Jun 22 21	1stBn, 4thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. C. Medina, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful introduction and distribution of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 320 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
30 Jun 22 22	HqBn, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
