2022 GA State Facilities Board (SFB) Minutes

Representatives from the Georgia National Guard described the approved MILCON National Guard Readiness Center at Ft Gordon and proposed facilities including a vehicle maintenance Facility in Army Aviation Support Facility. The Representatives from the 81st Readiness Division discussed current approved MILCON projects at MCLB Albany and Dobbins ARB. They also described planned MILCON and minor construction modernization projects at Decatur and Fort Valley, Georgia. No suitable vacant or underutilized were identified.

F. OTHER BUSINESS

- 1. GAARNG described the fourth year of modernization and renovation of GAARNG Readiness Centers across the state.
- Army Combat Fitness Test How do the Army Reserves plan to meet this new requirement? The GAARNG will have further discussions with DARB about their running track.
