

This cake and plaque marked the 35th anniversary of the Coast Guard tender LTIAC (WIM-227). The plaque was presented to the vessel by CAPT Joseph J. McClelland, Chief of Operations, 3d Coast Guard District, New York, during the celebration held on shipboard at the vessel's homeport, Coast Guard Base, Gloucester, N. J. The 173-foot tender was built in 1933 under the former Lighthouse Service.
