## Remedial Investigation for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Near Installation Restoration Site 6 Former Naval Station Treasure Island

Work Will Be Performed  
**On June 15, 2022, and from June 27, 2022 to July 1, 2022 between  
7:00 AM and 5:00 PM, excluding holidays**

The Navy's contractor, MultiMac Joint Venture, will be working at Former Naval Station Treasure Island adjacent to the Housing Area of IR Site 12.

<b>WHY IS WORK BEING DONE?</b>	The Navy is installing groundwater monitoring wells to analyze for the presence of PFAS.
<b>WHAT WILL BE DONE?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Borings will be advanced and soil samples collected using a hand-driven auger or a truck-mounted drill rig.</li> <li>• Groundwater monitoring wells will be installed in the borehole to collect groundwater samples.</li> <li>• Contractor will control dust during work by watering exposed soil and covering temporary stockpiles of soil.</li> </ul>
<b>WHERE WILL IT BE DONE?</b>	Work will be performed at one location adjacent to the boat ramp east of the jetty and at one location between Buildings 1243 and 1249. See attached figure for the locations of the investigation.
<b>HOW WILL IT IMPACT RESIDENTS?</b>	Noise associated with vehicles and drill rigs is anticipated. This work is not anticipated to require drill rigs to go through the residential neighborhood. All work will be performed between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.




