SUBJECT: Evaluation of Assessment, Monitoring, and Evaluation of Global Health Engagement Activities in USINDOPACOM, USEUCOM, and USAFRICOM (Project No. D2022-DEV0PB-0144.000)

We plan to begin our evaluation in June 2022. Our objective is to determine the extent to which the DoD assessed, monitored, and evaluated global health engagement (GHE) activities in USINDOPACOM, USEUCOM, and USAFRICOM, as required by DoD Security Cooperation and GHE policy. We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the evaluation at the: Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Special Operations and Low Intensity Conflict (ASD[SO/LIC]), Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs (ASD[HA]), Defense Security Cooperation Agency, Office of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, Military Departments (US Army, US Navy, US Air Force), Geographic Combatant Commands (USINDOPACOM, USEUCOM, and USAFRICOM), and the Uniformed Services University Center for Global Health Engagement. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.

Please provide us with a point of contact within **5 duty days** of the date of this memorandum. The point of contact should be someone with knowledge of GHE policies and activities and can adequately speak to the Assessment, Monitoring, and Evaluation of GHE and security cooperation activities. The point of contact must be a Government employee—GS-15, pay band equivalent, or the military equivalent.
