Fourth Five Year Review

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command Base Realignment and Closure Office (NAVFAC BRAC PMO), in consultation with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), has begun the fourth five-year review of the remedies implemented at the former Naval Air Warfare Center (NAWC) Trenton, New Jersey. The purpose of a five-year review is to ensure that the selected remedies are effectively protecting public health and the environment. The five-year review process is mandated under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) (also known as Superfund) for sites where the selected remedial action results in contaminants remaining above levels that allow for unlimited use and unrestricted exposure.

NAVFAC BRAC PMO will conduct interviews, review reports, and assess site conditions to evaluate if the remedies remain protective of human health and the environment. Public participation is encouraged and welcomed. If you are interested in participating in the interview process, please notify the contact person listed below by March 22, 2018. The five-year review is scheduled for completion in December 2018.
