- Languages Spoken at Home
 - English Only – 62%
 - Spanish Only – 16%
 - Asian/Pacific Islander – 14%
 - Other European Languages – 4%
 - Other Languages – 4%

- Language Access Ordinance
- Communicate More Effectively
- More than 112 Languages Spoken in Bay Area
- Most Frequently Spoken Languages:
 - English
 - Chinese Languages (75% Cantonese)
 - Spanish
 - Tagalog

Public Notice Languages



- Translations for Limited English Proficient Persons that equal 5% of population
- Spanish LEP = 6%
- Chinese Languages (Cantonese) LEP = 5%
- Public notices will direct persons to BRAC website for translations

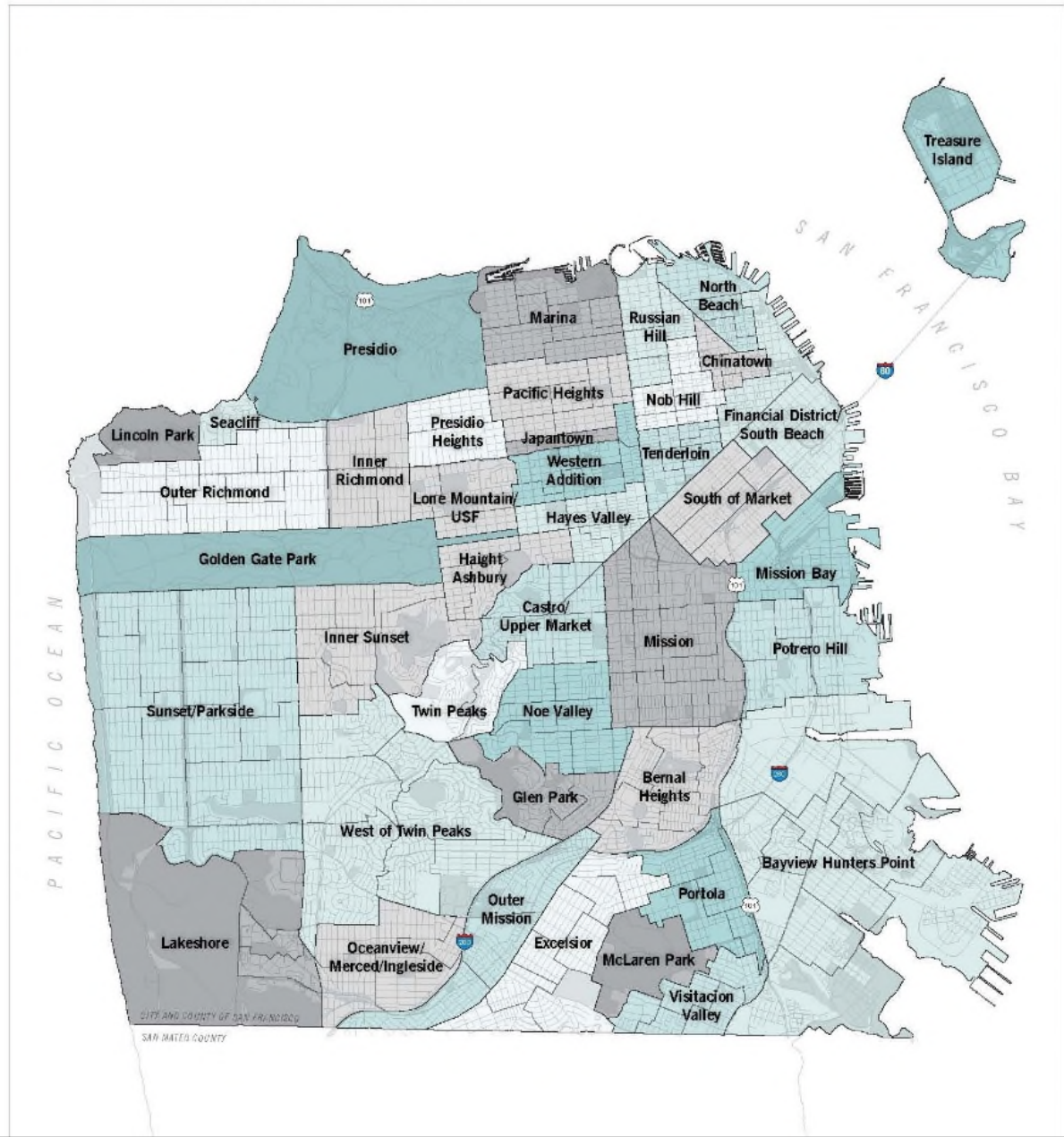

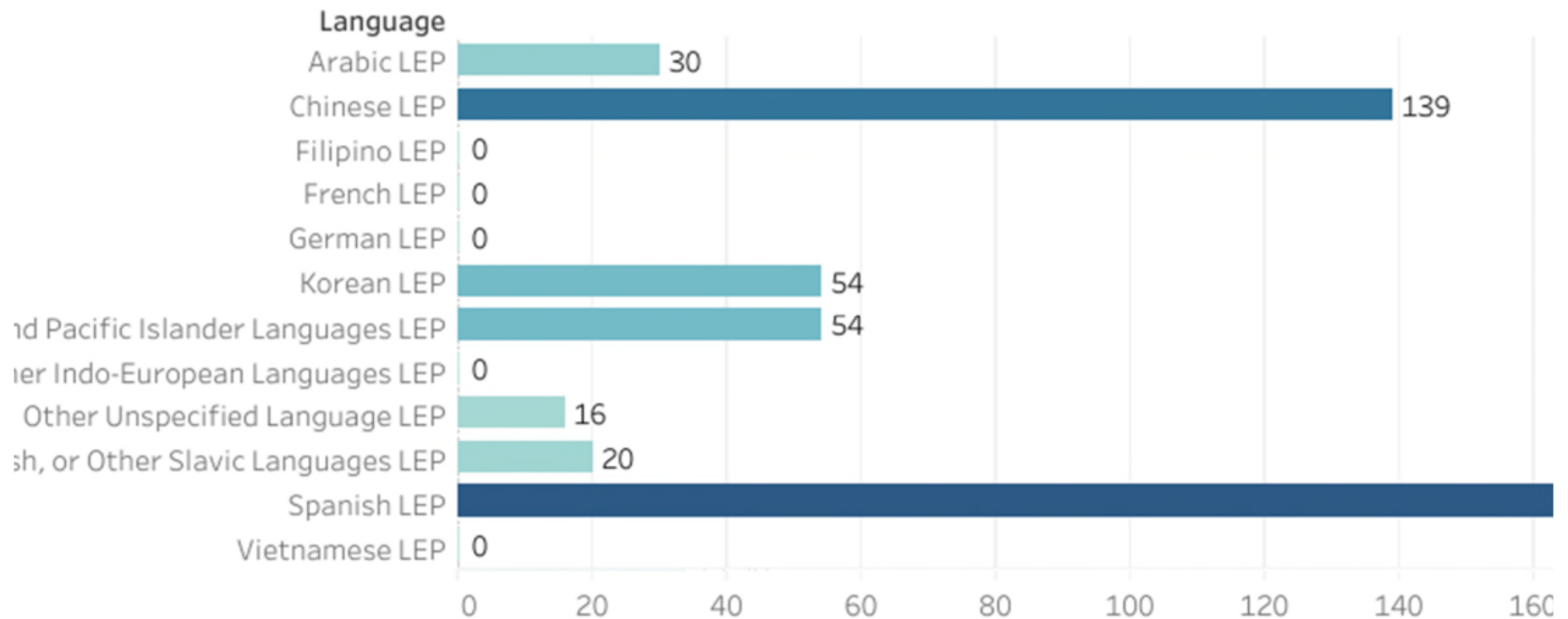
