

Base Summary

Base Property and Historical Use

Former Naval Station Treasure Island is located in San Francisco Bay, midway between San Francisco and Oakland, California. The site consists of two contiguous islands: the northern island named Treasure Island (TI) and the southern island named Yerba Buena or YBI. Yerba Buena is naturally formed island on which military activities date back to 1866 when the U.S. Government took possession of it to construct defensive fortifications. The Navy operated its first West Coast Naval Training Station on YBI until 1923 when the center was transferred to San Diego. Treasure Island is a man-made island and was constructed from 1936 to 1937 of sediments dredged from San Francisco Bay for the purpose of hosting the Golden Gate International Exposition World's Fair in 1939 and 1940. Yerba Buena Island continued to function as a Naval Receiving Station until World War II when naval operations were transferred to TI after the Navy acquired it by condemnation in 1942. The island became a major naval facility, processing approximately 12,000 military personnel per day for service overseas and upon their return to the United States.

Closure date, planned reuses, parcels transferred

Treasure Island was closed on 30 September 1997, as a BRAC III Major Closure. In 1997, the California State Legislature created a special reuse authority for Treasure Island, transferring local redevelopment authority status from San Francisco to the Treasure Island Development Authority (TIDA). TIDA is a state agency staffed by the San Francisco mayor's office and is the entity responsible for planning the reuse and redevelopment of the former installation.



Project A includes removal of excavated soil and debris currently stockpiled from previous phases of work at Westside SWDA (as indicated by the green polygon on map). The site will be graded with approximately 16,000 cubic yards of approved import fill. Noise associated with the heavy equipment backup alarms is anticipated during normal working hours. Dust control and air monitoring will be implemented to prevent airborne particulates and maintain public safety. The site surface will be restored with an approved grass seed mix compatible with adjacent areas.

Project B includes evaluations at seven subsurface radiological areas of interest (as indicated by the yellow circles on map). Prior to each evaluation, a temporary radiological control area will be established around each location. The evaluations will be performed by excavating and performing radiological surveys and scans of the excavated soil. All fieldwork will be conducted under third party oversight. The radiological isotope of concern for these seven areas of interest is Radium-226.



Originally acquired by the U.S. Navy and constructed as Camp Parks in 1942 to support the 1st Marine Air Gattalion (SEEBEES). The Navy operated Camp Parks, Camp Shoemaker and the U.S. Naval Hospital at the site until 1946. From 1946 to 1951, the installation was known as the Naval Air Station. In 1951, the Navy reacquired the property and transferred it to the U.S. Air Force and renamed Parks Air Force Base. The facility was transferred to Alameda County, all but 1600 acres was transferred to Alameda County (tracked as the Parks Air Force Base Formerly Used Defense Site). In 1980 the Army renamed Camp Parks as the Parks Air Force Base. During this period, the U.S. Navy Radiological Defense Laboratory, a tenant, conducted radiological experiments on plants and animals.

Areas of concern including a fire training area, former incinerator, underground storage tanks (USTS), wash racks, a landfill (disposal trenches), fuel spills and an arsenic spill. Other areas of concern include: metals, fuel solvents, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), radiological and medical wastes.





Site History

Naval Station Treasure Island (NSTI) is located in San Francisco Bay (Bay), midway between San Francisco and Oakland, California. The facility consists of two contiguous islands: Treasure Island (TI), which is approximately 550 acres, and Yerba Buena Island (YBI), which is approximately 550 acres. Stormwater outfalls and offshore sediments (Site 13) encompass approximately 563 additional acres. Treasure Island is a manmade island that is anchored to a natural rock island (YBI), that was constructed of materials dredged from the Bay in 1936. The island was developed to be the site of the 1939 Golden Gate
