Final Finding of Suitability to Transfer Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base – Willow Grove Shenandoah Woods Housing Complex Warminster, Pennsylvania (Approximately 55.12 Acres) As signed on 22 September 2015

This Errata Sheet outlines a correction to the Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) for the Shenandoah Woods Housing Complex, Warminster, Pennsylvania. The reuse of the property is updated and a July 6, 2017 Site Inspection Report for Exhibit D is attached. Accordingly, the following erratum is listed below:

SECTION 2.0 Property Description

1. Add the following update regarding future land use to the bottom of Page 3 of 18:

"In 2014, an environmental contamination issue emerged at the adjacent former NAWC Warminster. Perfluorinated compounds were detected in groundwater at levels above the EPA Safe Drinking Water Act Health Advisory levels. This environmental issue resulted in the need for extended due diligence by Warminster Township culminating in their position that the 29 acre land parcel (including 155 units of housing) is not developable due to the groundwater restrictions inhibiting construction and site development.

In 2017, the Township ultimately reached the conclusion that it was no longer in the public interest for them to continue pursuing future residential redevelopment of the 29 acre land parcel, as outlined in the HLRA's Redevelopment Plan, and that it now desired to acquire the property for community recreation purposes and open space uses. The Township proposes to demolish and remove the existing structures and improvements, and return the property to an open space condition.

The Navy's Quitclaim Deed will ensure that the property is used exclusively and in perpetuity for community recreation purposes and open space uses.

Regarding the remaining property, approximately 26 acres with 24 housing units were approved for a Department of Interior, Public Benefit Conveyance to Warminster Township for parks and recreation purposes, and the remaining 20 units of housing were approved for homeless use by the Aldie Foundation."

2. The following language is added to the end of the last paragraph, found on page 4 of 18:

", and July 6, 2017."

FINDING OF SUITABILITY TO TRANSFER

This FOST Errata was reviewed and concurred by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental of Protection and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Based on the information contained in the FOST, as amended by this Errata Sheet, and the notices and covenants that will be contained in the deed, the property is suitable for transfer.


