## ADJOURNMENT OF THE RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD (RAB) FOR FORMER NAVAL AIR WARFARE CENTER (NAWC) WARMINSTER, PA

The U.S. Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, is announcing the adjournment of the Restoration Advisory Board for former Naval Air Warfare Center (NAWC) Warminster, Pennsylvania. Title 32 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 202 allows for the adjournment of a restoration advisory board (RAB) when there is no longer documented sufficient, sustained community interest. The recorded minutes of the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meetings on April 18, 2012 and October 12, 2011 document the RAB concurrence with adjournment.

A technical review committee (TRC) has been established to review and comment on Navy environmental restoration activities at former NAWC Warminster. The first TRC meeting is scheduled for October 17, 2012 in the Warminster Municipal Authority Board Room at 415 Gibson Avenue, Warminster, PA.
