

PUBLIC NOTICE INFORMATION REPOSITORY TRANSITIONING TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FORMER LONG BEACH NAVAL COMPLEX LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA

The Department of the Navy (Navy) is transitioning the Information Repository (IR) for the Former Long Beach Naval Complex (LBNC), currently housed at the Long Beach Public Library in Long Beach, California, to the Navy's Administrative Record. The Former LBNC includes the Former Long Beach Naval Station and the Former Long Beach Naval Shipyard, which are located on Terminal Island between the City of Long Beach and the San Pedro District of the City of Los Angeles. The IR for Former LBNC contains only a subset of all environmental cleanup documents produced by the Navy. All of the Navy's cleanup documents available for public review may be obtained by contacting the Environmental Records Manager of the Administrative Record using the contact information provided below.
