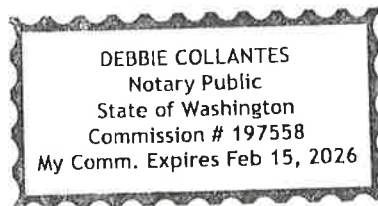

The U.S. Coast Guard has begun the public comment period for the Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS) for the proposed expansion and modernization of Base Seattle in Seattle, WA, in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act. The Coast Guard intends to acquire adjacent property and modernize and expand infrastructure and facilities at Base Seattle. Participation in the public comment period gives you the opportunity to attend public meetings and provide comments on the Draft PEIS.
