4 Oct 22 1	1stTB, CLR-1, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. H. Galarza, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful introduction and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
4 Oct 22 2	MCRD PI	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Sergeant S. K. Bagui, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abuse of position as a military recruiter. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,255 pay per month for 2 months, and reduction to E-1.
6 Oct 22 3	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Private First Class Z. C. Yucis, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy, wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, wrongful use of a controlled substance, resisting apprehension, and damaging non-military property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 11 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
6 Oct 22 4	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal J. D. Henson, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance and accessing a government computer to obtain protected information for an unauthorized purpose. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 10 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
7 Oct 22 5	H&SBn, MCI-E	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
11 Oct 22 6	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. P. Deters, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy, selling military property, larceny of military property, and unlawful entry. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

11 Oct 22 7	3d MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. B. Fairchild, pursuant to the accused's plea, of fraudulent enlistment. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 30 days of confinement.
13 Oct 22 8	H&SBn, MCI-E	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
13 Oct 22 9	1st Landing Support Bn, 1stMLG	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal E. Angeles, pursuant to the accused's plea, of disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 27 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
13 Oct 22 10	1stBn, 4thMar, 1stMarDiv	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal B. Y. Shim, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of carrying a concealed weapon and communicating a threat. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement and reduction to E-2.
14 Oct 22 11	MCIS	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal K. R. Saufley, pursuant to the accused's plea, of indecent conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
17 Oct 22 12	CLR-3, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
18 Oct 22 13	MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Cpl J. D. Suarez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance, introduction of a controlled substance with intent to distribute, distributing a controlled substance, and conspiracy. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 5 years of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
19 Oct 22 14	MAG-26, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Sergeant B. Castanedalopez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of obstruction of justice and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-3.

20 Oct 22 15	3dBn, 5thMar, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. C. Brooks, pursuant to the accused's plea, of aggravated assault. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 45 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
21 Oct 22 16	1stMaintBn, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class A. R. Crawford, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted use of a debit card without authorization to obtain property and use of a debit card without authorization to obtain property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
26 Oct 22 17	3dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Sergeant I. A. Schmidt, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery upon a child, child endangerment, breach of the peace, and violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 28 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
27 Oct 22 18	III MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Corporal N. J. Bautista, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault upon a enforcement officer, domestic violence, resisting apprehension, willfully damaging military property, disorderly conduct, damaging non-military property, and aggravated assault with the infliction of substantial bodily harm upon a spouse. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 400 days of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
