6 Sep 22 1	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. W. Chisolm, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, assault consummated by battery, child endangerment, and drunk driving. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 40 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
6 Sep 22 2	2dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. L. Ervin, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing child pornography, distributing child pornography, and soliciting the distribution of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 5 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
8 Sep 22 3	HqHqRon, MCAS Miramar	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal F. F. Castro, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abusive sexual contact and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 2 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,200 pay per month for 2 months, and reduction to E-1.
12 Sep 22 4	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. Molgadodelgado, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 30 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
14 Sep 22 5	5thMar, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private K. J. King, pursuant to the accused's plea, of unauthorized absence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 90 days of confinement.
15 Sep 22 6	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private A. H. Puckett, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of unauthorized absence, willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the

		military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days of confinement and forfeiture of \$200 pay per month for 1 month.
15 Sep 22 7	MCAS Cherry Point	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
15 Sep 22 8	MCSFR	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant T. J. Hauck, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-6.
16 Sep 22 9	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. L. Leonti, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 36 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Sep 22 10	H&SBn, MCI-E	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Master Sergeant H. K. Marquez III, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-6 and a letter of reprimand.
19 Sep 22 11	HqHqRon, MCAS Miramar	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant A. E. Bueno, pursuant to the accused's plea, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,600 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-3.
28 Sep 22 12	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. T. Rohlfs of involuntary manslaughter and negligent homicide. The military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
29 Sep 22 13	1stMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal F. I. Knight, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of extortion and obstructing justice. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 18 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
30 Sep 22 14	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Sergeant E. Amezcua, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 23 months of

		confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances for 23 months, and reduction to E-1.
30 Sep 22 15	MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Corporal J. L. Eshelman, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy and willful dereliction of duty. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
