The objective of this evaluation is to determine the extent to which the U.S. Air Force have implemented sustaining engineering actions to ensure that the Upgraded Early Warning Radar (UEWR) system is capable, reliable, and available to meet mission requirements while managing risks. We will also determine whether the program has addressed an open recommendation made in Report No.DODIG-2016-133, "Evaluation of the Integrated Tactical Warning/Attack Assessment Ground-Based Radars." We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives.

We intend to hold an entrance conference the week of October 24, 2022, to begin coordination of our evaluation.
