5. Action on minutes of previous meetings. All members reviewed the previous minutes and agreed to accept them.

6. Project summaries.

a. Number of projects reviewed: 24

b. Number recommended for joint construction: 1

c. Number recommended for unilateral construction: 19

d. Number not recommended for construction: 0

e. Number of prior recommendations to remove: 4

7. Project listing is provided in enclosure 1. Additional notes for some of these projects follow:

a. Lines 3 and Line 9. Line 3 is one of two courses of action to build in King County/City of North Bend. This is the IRP (Infrastructure Requirements Plan) for the FMS (Field Maintenance Shop) only. Line 9 is the other course of action as the UFR (Unfunded Request) that would include the FMS and the Readiness Center portion. Both have been previously voted for unilateral.

b. Line 6 and Line 21. Line 6 replaces Line 21 as the AASF#2 (Army Aviation Support Facility) will have to move from FAFB (Fairchild Air Force Base) to Wenatchee/Pangborn Airport. Line 6 was voted for and approved as unilateral.

c. Line 7. This new project received a unanimous vote for unilateral. While this Regional Training Institute would be able to train Soldiers from multiple COMPOs (Components) of the Army, it is not expected to have cadre or instructors from COMPO 1 and COMPO 3.

c. Line 14. This project was initially an SRM (Sustainment, Restoration, Modernization) project. However, during the bidding process, the cost exceeded the planned \$1.9 million. Therefore, WAARNG had to move this to a UMMC (Unspecified Minor MILCON Construction) project. This was a supplement request after last year's Board, that was approved. It was presented to the Board for voting and tracking purposes. The board approved this as a unilateral project.

d. Line 15. The TUAS project remains listed as unilateral. This was previously a UFR project for many years, but WAARNG has not been able to get this project approved due to TUAS being lower priority. Have moved this to UMMC for now and remains as unilateral.

e. Line 18. This DFAC (Dining Facility) is a new project brought to the Board. This project received a unanimous vote for unilateral.

f. Line 22. This will be removed for now, as WAARNG must complete the Joint Force Headquarters Readiness Center before a Non-Org Parking garage can be constructed. This has an opportunity to be reinstated when needed.

g. Line 23. Air Guard East stated that this project will not go forward, hence will remove this from the list.

h. Line 24. Air Guard West mentioned that this project is working towards construction award, and no longer needs to be listed.

8. Additional items:

a. The Active Component representatives mentioned an emerging requirement on DD1390/91s. Specifically, it was mentioned that any project on JBLM or YTC requires Garrison Commander to approve and sign the DD 1390/91. It is understood that any project on Active Component land requires site approval by the Garrison command. This might be done either a Memorandum of Agreement or Understanding. This matter will be researched and reviewed to clarify the way forward on these projects.

b. The USAR is still working to divest of Kandle Hall in Tacoma, and Nuttall Hall in Tumwater, allowing WAARNG to take over via a REAP (Real Estate Action Plan). However, WAARNG has learned of environmental issues that are delaying this divestiture until FY 25. USAR representatives will inquire about this and get a clear timeline of these divestitures, so WAARNG can plan to acquire them.

c. WAARNG also inquired with the US Navy Reserve representative regarding the US Marine Corp vacating a Naval Facility in Spokane. WAARNG has potential interest if a portion of this building becomes available.

d. WAARNG previously mentioned of plans to divest of the Redmond Readiness Center. USAR had potential interest in this facility. However, this will likely be delayed for a significant amount of time considering updated WAARNG force structure requirements and the delay of acquiring Kandle and Nuttall Hall.

9. Next meeting will be scheduled for either July or August 2022. Specific date will be announced at a later time.
