6 Jul 22 1	II MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. T. Raines, pursuant to the accused's plea, of soliciting the commission of an offense. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 8 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
7 Jul 22 2	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. M. Hickland, pursuant to the accused's plea, of reckless driving resulting in injury. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
7 Jul 22 3	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Foster, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. I. Campos, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of negligently damaging military property, drunk driving, domestic violence by strangulation, domestic violence by assault, and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 70 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
11 Jul 22 4	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Hospitalman R. A. Castillo, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of abusive sexual contact and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months of confinement and reduction to E-1.
13 Jul 22 5	1stTSB, CLR-1, 1stMLG	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant A. Trejosalguera, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order and willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 50 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.

14 Jul 22 6	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private D. A. Jordevenson, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, willfully disobeying of a noncommissioned officer, violation of a lawful general order, wrongful introduction of a controlled substance, wrongful use of a controlled substance, obstruction of justice, and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 14 months of confinement, and total forfeiture of all pay and allowances.
15 Jul 22 7	2dMarRdrBn, MARSOC	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
15 Jul 22 8	VMGR-152, MAG-12, 1stMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. M. Naill, pursuant to the accused's plea, of domestic assault by strangulation. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
19 Jul 22 9	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Corporal A. Martinez, pursuant to the accused's plea, of making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of restriction.
20 Jul 22 10	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
22 Jul 22 11	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
26 Jul 22 12	MIG, II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal K. D. Medina, pursuant to the accused's pleas, wrongful introduction and use of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 37 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
27 Jul 22 13	HqSptBn, MCI-E	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class S. L. Poe, pursuant to the accused's plea, of unauthorized absence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 3 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
27 Jul 22 14	WTBn, MCI-NCR	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Sergeant C. J. Bandy, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny and violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$250 pay per month for 1 month and reduction to E-3.

27 Jul 22 15	3dBn, 5thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. L. Olmstead, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery upon a spouse and violation of a lawful order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 75 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
29 Jul 22 16	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal P. G. Vazquez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography and soliciting a minor to create child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 60 months of confinement, and total forfeiture of all pay and allowances.
29 Jul 22 17	WTBn, MCI-NCR	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Corporal C. R. Winstead, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of extortion and violation of a lawful order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement and reduction to E-3.
29 Jul 22 18	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members convicted Corporal D. L. Ruiz of abusive sexual contact. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-1.
29 Jul 22 19	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
