SUBJECT: Audit of DoD Actions to Implement Software Assurance Countermeasures Throughout the Weapon System Acquisition Life Cycle (Project No. D2023-D000CS-0097.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin the self-initiated subject audit in April 2023. The objective of this audit is to determine whether DoD program management offices are implementing software assurance countermeasures to mitigate software vulnerabilities throughout the weapon system acquisition life cycle. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform the audit in accordance with the Government Accountability Office's generally accepted government auditing standards.

We will perform the audit at the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Research and Engineering, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment, and selected DoD program management offices. We may identify additional locations during the audit.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for the audit within **5 days** of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—and knowledgeable of the systems engineering and software development processes related to the objective.
