SUBJECT: Evaluation of the Security Assistance Group-Ukraine Coordination of the Movement of Defense Articles to Ukraine (Project No. D2023-DEV0PE-0111.000)

The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that we plan to begin this evaluation in April 2023. The objective of the evaluation is to determine the effectiveness and efficiency of the Security Assistance Group-Ukraine's management, tracking, and coordination of the movement of U.S. defense articles to Ukraine. We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives. We plan to perform this evaluation in accordance with the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency, "Quality Standards for Inspections and Evaluations."

We will perform the evaluation at Rzeszow, Poland; Wiesbaden, Germany; and Stuttgart, Germany. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation.

We request that you designate a staff member to serve as our point of contact for this evaluation within 5 days of receipt of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or military equivalent—knowledgeable of air, sea, and ground movement of U.S. defense articles for support to Ukraine in the U.S. European Command area of responsibility.
