SUBJECT: UTD/CTD for MAP/CAP 88-23(I), "Update Authorized R&R Locations and Destinations"

1. Purpose: This item adds eight additional countries designated as chargeable rest and recuperation (R&R) leave duty locations. SUBJECT: Additional Designated Duty Locations in the Rest and Recuperation Leave Program

Effective immediately, the land areas of Algeria, Burundi, Cameroon (North and Far North), Libya, Mali, Niger, South Sudan, and Tunisia are hereby designated as chargeable rest and recuperation (R&R) leave duty locations for a 2-year period from the date of this memorandum. Furthermore, the R&R destination for these duty locations is the airport closest to the Service member's leave location. The Director, Defense Human Resources Activity will include these duty locations in an update to the R&R table in the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR) Supplements section of the Defense Travel Management Office website.

If a land area so designated by this memorandum no longer meets the chargeable R&R leave criteria contained in DoD Instruction (DoDI) 1327.06, the Commander, U.S. Africa Command shall immediately terminate the chargeable R&R leave program for that land area.

The Secretaries of the Military Departments are responsible for funding the reimbursable expenses of their Service members for authorized R&R leave transportation as described in the JTR and DoDI 1327.06.
