1 May 23  1	1stCEB 1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal A. Bocardocovarrubias, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
1 May 23  2	3dMaintBn, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Sergeant D. W. Gallishaw, pursuant to the accused's plea, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days of confinement and reduction to E-3.
4 May 23  3	MEPS, San Antonio, TX	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant M. A. Salgado, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny and use of a credit or debit card without authorization. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
5 May 23  4	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and all specifications.
9 May 23  5	MARFORSOC	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
13 May 23  6	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Sergeant E. J. Siefkes, pursuant to the accused's plea, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
15 May 23  7	II MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal J. T. Horvath, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possessing child pornography, viewing child pornography, and possessing child pornography with intent to distribute. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 3 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

17 May 23 8	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, a military judge convicted Corporal G. Jimenez-Carlos, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 24 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
17 May 23 9	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. Huber, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual assault of a child under 16 and viewing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 36 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
17 May 23 10	MarDet, Ft Lee, VA	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
18 May 23 11	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a panel of members convicted Gunnery Sergeant O. RodriguezDejesus of sexual assault and domestic violence. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 412 days of confinement, and reduction to E-3.
19 May 23 12	MACG-28	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
19 May 23 13	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal G. Locklear, pursuant to the accused's plea, of aggravated assault. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
22 May 23 14	SecForBn, Kings Bay, GA	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Private T. Jones, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of breaking restriction, flight from apprehension, larceny, receiving stolen property, misappropriation, and conspiracy. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,278 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
23 May 23 15	MCRD PI	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. K. McCord, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of use of a credit or debit card without authorization and conspiracy. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, a fine of \$3,000, and reduction to E-1.

23 May 23 16	HqSptBn, MCI-W	At an Art. 16(c) (2) (A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. P. Spence of willful dereliction of duty. The military judge sentenced the accused to 21 days of hard labor.
24 May 23	MCAGCC	Following the previous conviction of Corporal M. C. Bunton at a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms for conspiracy, failure to go to an appointed place of duty, and false official statements on 12 September 2020, the appellate court remanded the accused's sentence for a rehearing. At the sentence rehearing, the military judge, consistent with the post-trial agreement, sentenced the accused to 24 months of confinement and reduction to E-1.
25 May 23 17	Wpns & Field TrngBn	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Corporal T. A. Crum, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of failure to obey a lawful order and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 54 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
