1 Mar 23 1	10thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
2 Mar 23 2	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. J. Galindo, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted sexual abuse of a child involving indecent communications and possession of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 36 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
2 Mar 23 3	3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Private First Class N. B. Perez, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 129 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
2 Mar 23 4	MARFORPAC	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
3 Mar 23 5	MACG-38, 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. T. Hope, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of obstructing justice and indecent language. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, forfeiture of two-thirds pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
7 Mar 23 6	III MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant T. L. Brunson Jr., pursuant to the accused's pleas, of aggravated assault by strangulation and assault consummated by battery on an intimate partner. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 366 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.

8 Mar 23 7	3dSupBn, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant A. J. Moore, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
14 Mar 23 8	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal C. R. Thomas, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by battery on his spouse. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Mar 23 9	MACG-28, 2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Corporal T. A. Carruth, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Mar 23 10	MARFORCOM	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. A. Lott of making a false official statement and abusive sexual contact. The military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 90 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
22 Mar 23 11	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private P. J. Marquez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession and viewing child pornography and soliciting the distribution of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 84 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
24 Mar 23 12	Field Medical Training Bn West	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. A. Dizona, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-3.
29 Mar 23 13	MCI-West	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.

30 Mar 23 14	HqSptBn, MCI-West	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. D. Ware, pursuant to the accused's plea, of unauthorized absence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 30 days of hard labor, forfeiture of \$400 pay per month for 1 month, reduction to E-2.
31 Mar 23 15	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Sergeant P. A. Watkins, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence and assault by strangulation. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 28 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
31 Mar 23 16	1stBn, 8thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private R. D. Vallier, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violations of a lawful general order and negligent discharge of a firearm. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and 78 days of confinement.
31 Mar 23 17	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant J. C. Hill, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to no punishment.
