2 Oct 23  1	HQBN, 1st MLG	At an Art. 16(c)(2)(A) special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Master Gunnery Sergeant C. McEntire, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a reprimand, forfeitures of \$5,414 for one month, and restriction for 30 days.
2 Oct 23  2	1st MarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. Beltranhernandez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of obstructing justice. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge and reduction to E-1.
2 Oct 23  3	1st MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. L. Dorsey, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession and distribution of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 36 months of confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
3 Oct 23  4	7th ESB, 1st MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal C. D. Dubois, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of disrespect towards a sentinel and assault upon a law enforcement officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 1 month of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
3 Oct 23  5	2d Main. Bn, 2d MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. C. Hamilton, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of one violation of desertion. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 5 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
4 Oct 23  6	MCAS Miramar	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant L. A. Lockard III, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted sexual abuse of a child and soliciting production of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 20 months confinement and reduction to E-1.
5 Oct 23  7	1st MarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. Lebourgeois, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of receiving and viewing child pornography and distributing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge

		sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 30 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.
5 Oct 23 8	MAG-14	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. Taggart, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1.
12 Oct 23 9	CLR-2, 2d MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private G. Torresanariba, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to forfeitures of \$250 per month for three months.
13 Oct 23 10	1st Bn, 8th Marines	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class B. C. Collins, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior officer and desertion. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 150 days confinement, and reduction to E-1.
26 Oct 23 11	CLR-27, 2d MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal L. D. Fernandez, pursuant to his pleas, of soliciting an offense, violating a lawful general order, and possession of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused a reduction to E-1.
27 Oct 23 12	1st MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
27 Oct 23 13	1st MLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Captain D. J. Alvey, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted sexual abuse of a child and conduct unbecoming an officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dismissal and 9 months confinement.
30 Oct 23 14	MCTBN, SOI-W, TRNG CMD	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant R. H. Koppel, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-4.
31 Oct 23 15	MCAS Miramar	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Corporal M. J. Solano, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence and stalking. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months confinement, and reduction to E-1.
